

Clearing the Memory of the TI-73 Graphing Calculator

When beginning a new lesson with the calculator it is sometimes helpful to RESET the memory of the calculator. This will reset the calculator back to the condition it was when it was taken out of the package for the first time. Warning: All programs will be cleared.

Turn the calculator ON

Press 2nd Mem (0)

```
MEMO 0000
1:About
2:Check RAM...
3:Check APPs...
4:Delete...
5:Clear Home
6:ClrAllLists
7:Reset...
```

Select 7: Reset by
•pressing 7 or
•using the cursor arrows to move to 7 and ENTER

```
RESET
1:All RAM...
2:Defaults...
```

Select 1. All Ram by pressing
•1 or
•ENTER

```
RESET RAM
1:No
2:Reset

Resetting RAM
erases all data
and Programs.
```

Select 2. Reset by pressing
•2 or
•ENTER
You will get the screen at the right that tells you the RAM has been cleared.

```
GRAPH EXPLORER SOFTWARE
1.60

RAM cleared
```

You now have a calculator that is set up just like when you got it out of the package.
